SPIRITUAL GIFT DEFINITIONS AND SCRIPTURE REFERENCES

The following are descriptions of Spiritual Gifts and suggested Dream Team opportunities to use your gifts.

Administration

The gift of administration is the divine strength or ability to organize multiple tasks and groups of people to accomplish projects. Luke 14:28-30; Acts 6:1-7; 1 Corinthians 12:28 (Campus Support, Contributions Team, CF Kids Guest Services, Setup/Teardown, Video Production, IT Team, Stewardship Team)

Apostleship

The gift of apostleship is the divine strength or ability to pioneer new churches and ministries through planting, overseeing, and training. Acts 15:22-35; 1 Corinthians 12:28; 2 Corinthians 12:12; Galatians 2:7-10; Ephesians 4:11-14 (Journey Team, LifeGroup Leader)

Craftsmanship

The gift of craftsmanship is the divine strength or ability to plan, build, and work with your hands in construction environments to accomplish multiple ministry applications. Exodus 30:22, 31:3-11; 2 Chronicles 34:9-13; Acts 18:2-3 (Facilities, CF Kids, CF Students, Setup/Teardown Events, Video Production, Creative Environments)

Discernment

The gift of discernment is the divine strength or ability to distinguish between right and wrong motives and situations. Matthew 16:21-23; Acts 5:1-11, 16:16-18; 1 Corinthians 12:10; 1 John 4:1-6 (Journey Team, Special Needs, CF Kids Guest Services, Care Team, Prayer Team, Connections Team)

Evangelism

The gift of evangelism is the divine strength or ability to effectively share the gospel of Jesus Christ with non-believers. Acts 8:5-6, 8:26-40, 14:21, 21:8; Ephesians 4:11-14 (Belle Glade, Life Missions, LifeGroup Leader, CF Students, Prayer Team, Care Team)

Exhortation

The gift of exhortation is the divine strength or ability to encourage others through the written or spoken word empowered by Biblical truth. Acts 14:22; Romans 12:8; 1 Timothy 4:13; Hebrews 10:24-25 (Belle Glade, Life Missions, Events, Greeters, Journey Team, LifeGroup Leader, CF Kids, CF Students, Hospitality Team, CF Kids Guest Services, Care Team, Welcome Team, Connections Team)

Faith

The gift of faith is the divine strength or ability to believe God for unseen supernatural results in every area of life. Acts 11:22-24; Romans 4:18-21; 1 Corinthians 12:9; Hebrews 11 (All Teams)

Giving

The gift of giving is the divine strength or ability to invest generously by returning the tithes and giving offerings for the purpose of advancing the Kingdom of God on earth. Mark 12:41-44; Romans 12:8; 2 Corinthians 8:1-7, 9:2-7 (Stewardship Team)

Healing

The gift of healing is the divine strength or ability to act as an intermediary in faith, prayer, and by the laying-on of hands for the healing of physical and mental illnesses. Acts 3:1-10, 9:32-35, 28:7-10; 1 Corinthians 12:9, 28 (Medical Team, Special Needs, Prayer Team)

Helps

The gift of helps is the divine strength or ability to work in a supportive role for the accomplishment of tasks in Christian ministry. Mark 15:40-41; Acts 9:36; Romans 16:1-2; 1 Corinthians 12:28 (Campus Support, Welcome Team, Facilities, Events, Medical Team, Connections Team)

Hospitality

The gift of hospitality is the divine strength or ability to create warm, welcoming environments for others in places such as your home, office, or church. Acts 16:14-15; Romans 12:13, 16:23; Hebrews 13:1-2; 1 Peter 4:9 (Events, Welcome Team, Journey Team, CF Students, CF Kids Guest Services, Connections Team)

Intercession

The gift of intercession is the divine strength or ability to pray for someone, something, or someplace, believing for profound results. Hebrews 7:25; Colossians 1:9-12, 4:12-13; James 5:14-16 (Prayer Team, Care Team, LifeGroup Leader)

Knowledge

The gift of knowledge is the divine strength or ability to understand and to bring clarity to situations and circumstances often accompanied by a word from God. Acts 5:1-11; 1 Corinthians 12:8; Colossians 2:2-3 (Belle Glade, Life Missions, Medical Team, Special Needs, Church Online, Prayer Team)

Leadership

The gift of leadership is the divine strength or ability to influence people effectively while directing and focusing them on a shared mission. Romans 12:8; 1 Timothy 3:1-13, 5:17; Hebrews 13:17 (All Teams)

Mercy

The gift of mercy is the divine strength or ability to feel empathy and to care for those who are hurting in any way. Matthew 9:35-36; Mark 9:41; Romans 12:8; 1 Thessalonians 5:14 (Belle Glade, Life Missions, LifeGroup Leader, Medical Team, Special Needs, Care Team)

Miracles

The gift of miracles is the divine strength or ability to alter the natural outcomes of life in a supernatural way through prayer, faith, and divine direction. Acts 9:36-42, 19:11-12, 20:7-12; Romans 15:18-19; 1 Corinthians 12:10, 28 (Belle Glade, Life Missions, Medical Team, Prayer Team)

Missionary

The gift of missions is the divine strength or ability to reach others outside of your culture. Acts 8:4, 13:2-3, 22:21; Romans 10:15 (Belle Glade, Life Missions, LifeGroup Leader, Care Team)

Music/Worship

The gift of music/worship is the divine strength or ability to sing, dance, or play an instrument primarily for the purpose of helping others worship God. Deuteronomy 31:22; 1 Samuel 16:16; 1 Chronicles 16:41-42; 2 Chronicles 5:12-13, 34:12; Psalm 150 (CF Kids, CF Students, CF Worship Team)

Pastor/Shepherd

The gift of pastor/shepherd is the divine strength or ability to care for the personal and spiritual needs of others. John 10:1-18; Ephesians 4:11-14; 1 Timothy 3:1-7; 1 Peter 5:1-3 (Journey Team, LifeGroup Leader, CF Kids, CF Students, Church Online)

Prophecy

The gift of prophecy is the divine strength or ability to speak boldly and bring clarity to scriptural truth. Acts 2:37-40, 7:51-53, 26:24-29; 1 Corinthians 14:1-4; 1 Thessalonians 1:5 (Prayer Team, LifeGroup Leader)

Service

The gift of serving is the divine strength or ability to do small or great tasks in working for the overall good of the body of Christ. Acts 6:1-7; Romans 12:7; Galatians 6:10; 1 Timothy 1:16-18; Titus 3:14 (Campus Support, Welcome Team, CF Kids, Setup/Teardown, Facilities, Events)

Teaching

The gift of teaching is the divine strength or ability to study and learn from the Scriptures primarily to bring understanding and clarity to others. Acts 18:24-28, 20:20-21; 1 Corinthians 12:28; Ephesians 4:11-14 (LifeGroup Leader)

Tongues/Interpretation

The gift of tongues/interpretation is the divine strength or ability to pray in a heavenly language. The gift of tongues is often accompanied by interpretation and should be used appropriately. Acts 2:1-13; 1 Corinthians 12:10, 14:1-14 (Prayer Team)

Wisdom

The gift of wisdom is the divine strength or ability to apply the truths of Scripture in a practical way. Acts 6:3,10; 1 Corinthians 2:6-13, 12:8 (CF Worship, Prayer Team, LifeGroup Leader)
